

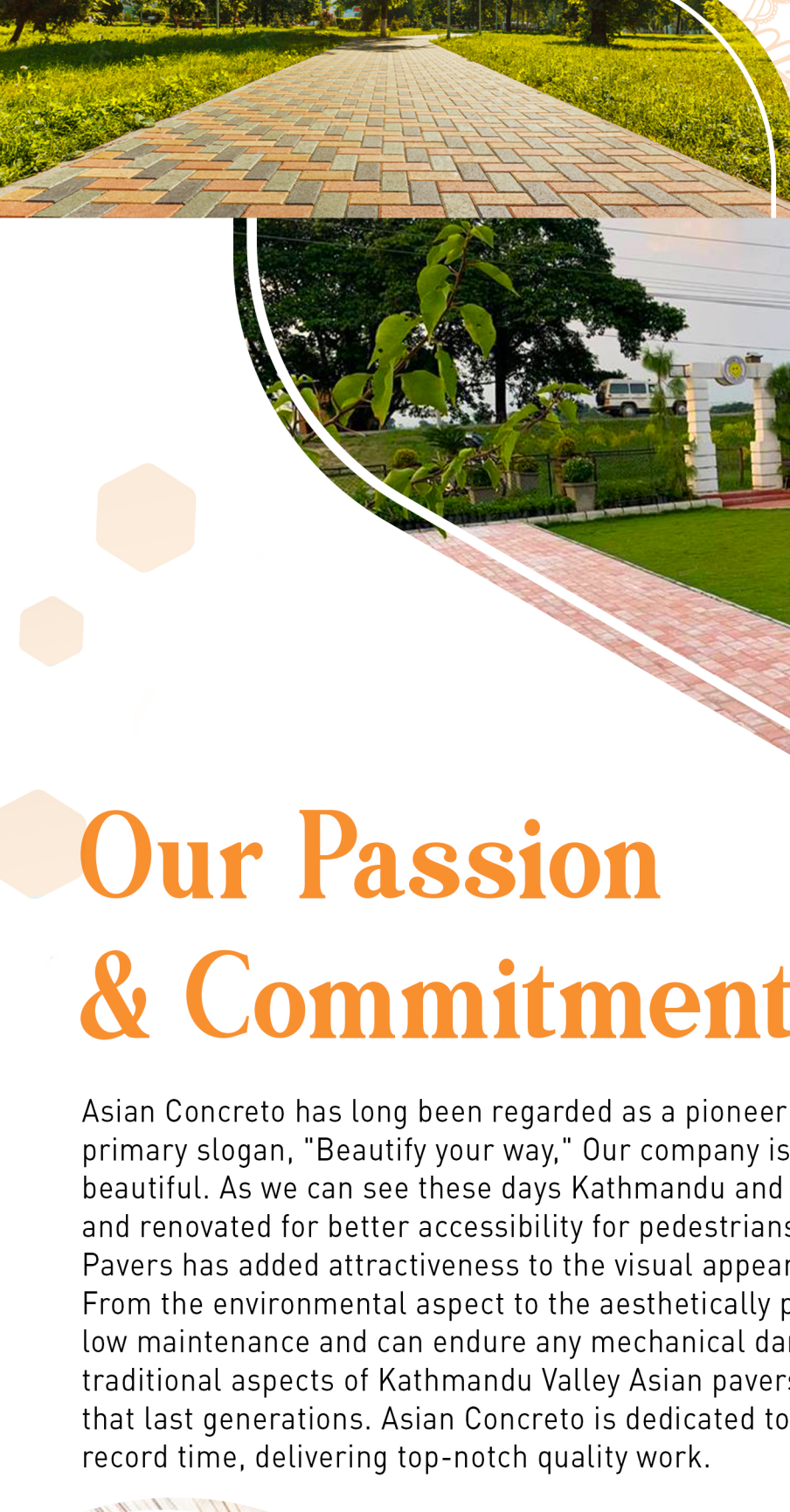

Products Used : Asian Kerbstone, Asian Rectangular Pavers.

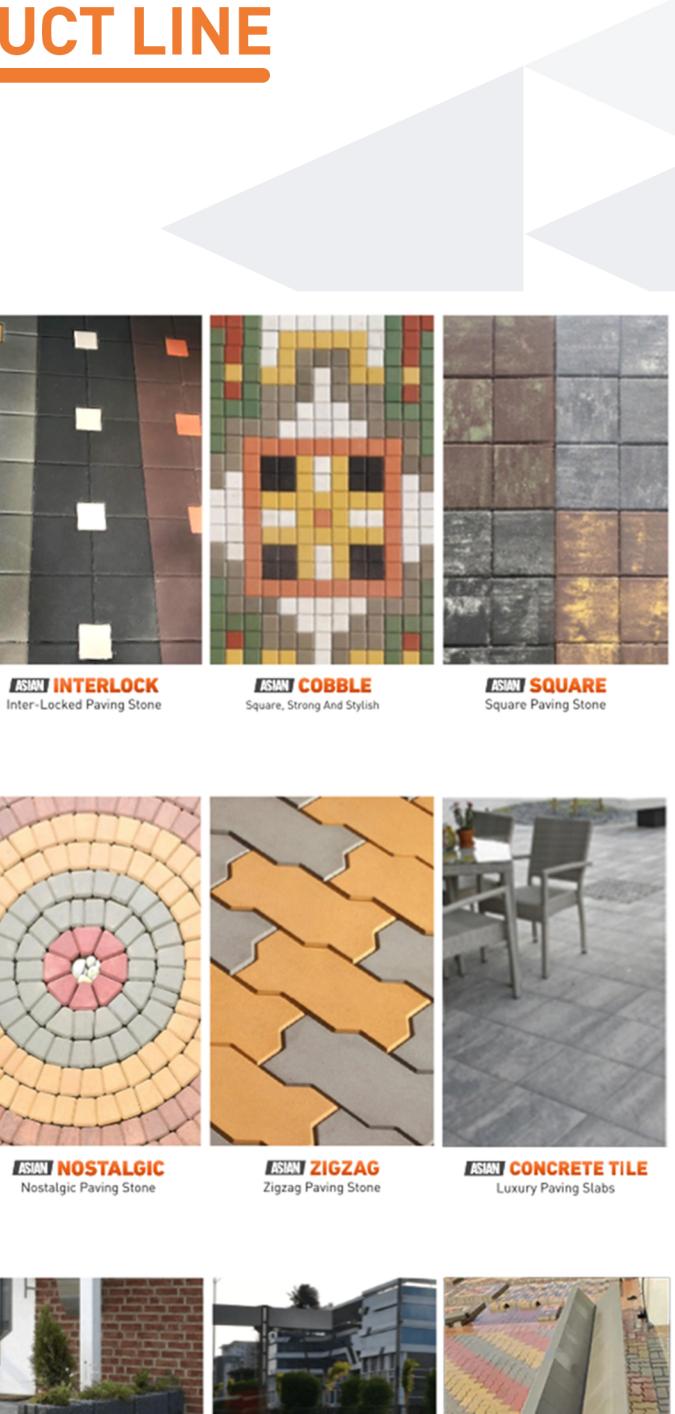

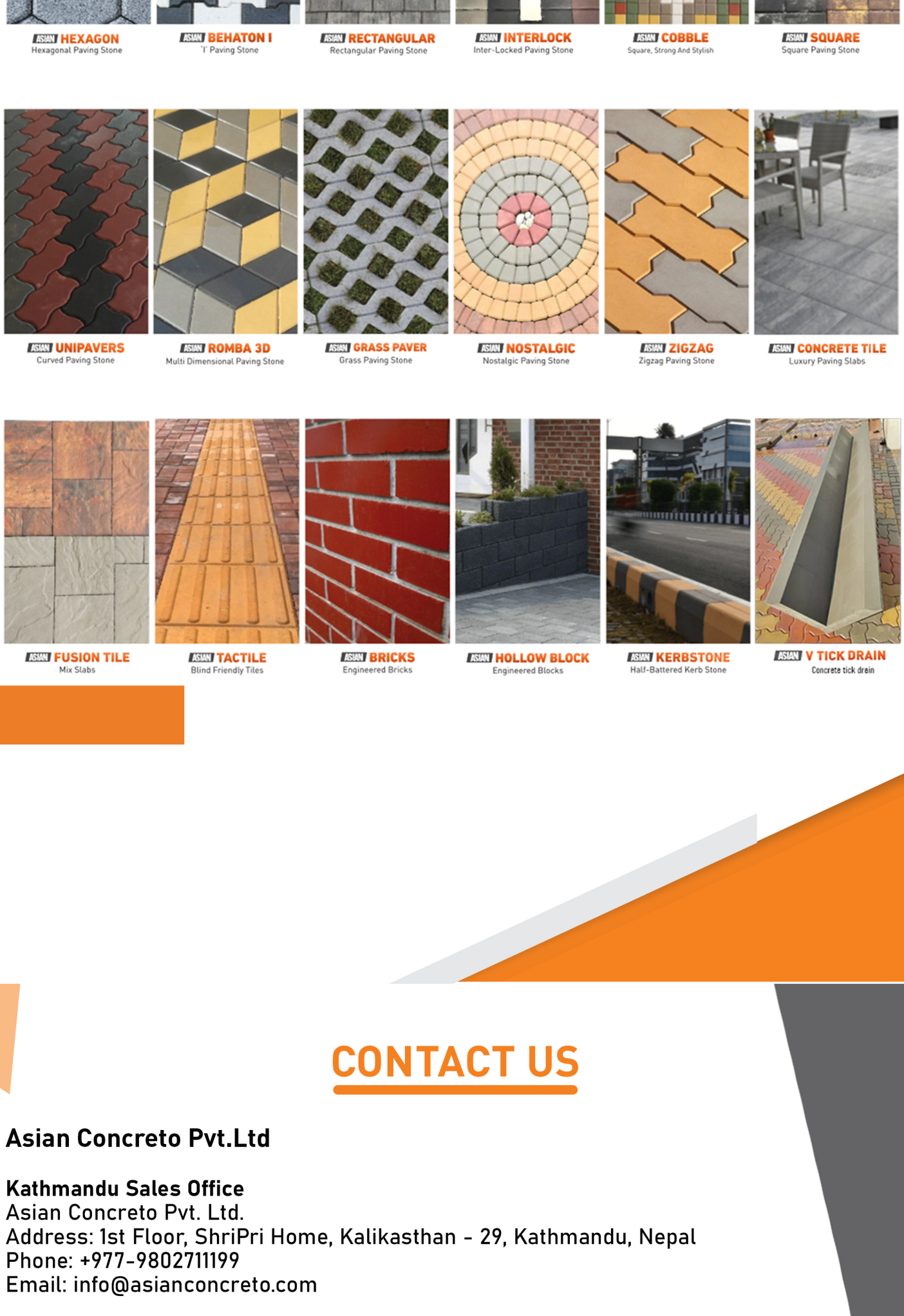
Maya Devi Temple Road
